Description of the institution

Mariupol State University (MSU) (<u>en.mdu.in.ua/</u>) is a **classical higher education institution** with a wide network of international contacts and long-standing reputation in the Ukrainian and foreign educational communities. MSU is a centre of training of highly qualified specialists in international relations; teaching, interpretation and translation of foreign languages; journalism to constitute the brainpower of the society. MSU has developed and has been successfully implementing its own pattern of international cooperation.

International activities of the university are regulated by the agreements on cooperation with the growing number of foreign partners. By 2015, the University signed 97 agreements on cooperation with foreign partners.

Internships programs are one of the most important and promising forms of international cooperation of MSU. Every year more than 300 students and instructors participate in different educational, scientific and cultural programmes in Austria, Bulgaria, Greece, Georgia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Germany, Poland, Portugal, the USA, Czech Republic and other states.

MSU is **the member of various international organizations** such as follows: the European Public Law Organization, the European University Association, Mediterranean Universities Union, Association of Rectors of Pedagogical Universities in Europe, Association of Juridical Universities of the CIS Countries, the European Public Law Organization etc.

University has 11 scientific-educational and cultural centres, established with the assistance of foreign partners (Representative office of European Public Law Organization, Institute of Ukraine-Greece Friendship and Hellenic Studies, Representative office of Dante Alighieri Society, Italian Cultural Centre as well as Polish, Israeli, Greek and Chinese ones).

Aim and planned outcomes of the project

Name of the project: Internationalization as a way of improving the competitiveness of the modern university

The aim of the project is development and implementation of the modern internationalization university strategy to establish MSU as a leading international university, and maintain a competitive advantage in the key markets.

The project outcomes include:

I. Analysis of the current internal and external factors, SWOT-analysis of international activities of university.

II. Development of the higher education internationalization strategy in university.

III. Modernization of the university management structure for implementation of modern higher education internationalization strategy.

IV. Implementation of higher education internationalization strategy in MSU.

Expectations from the cooperation with the UK university

to investigate how scholarship, teaching, research and innovation are carried out in international programmes;
