Description of institution

Poltava National Technical Yuri Kondratyuk University (pntu.edu.ua/en/) has educational traditions since 1818 and now it's the biggest educational centre in Poltava region.

University includes 8 faculties: Architecture Faculty; Civil Engineering Faculty; Faculty of Humanities; Faculty of Information and Telecommunication Technologies and Systems; Oil-Gas and Nature Management Faculty; Faculty of Finance and Economics, Management and Business faculty, Electro Engineering faculty. University also includes Myrgorod Art-Industrial M.V. Gogol College and Poltava Oil and Gas College. Now University has approximately 10 thousand students and staff.

Research and innovation: 10 scientific fundamental research schools in the sphere of science, engineering and architecture. The main research fields: mechanization of technologies and processes of building production; civil engineering and effective foundations; concrete and masonry structures; regional social and economic policy; automation of technological processes; vibrating machines and technology; applied ecology and energy efficiency.

International cooperation: In annual global web-ranking universities in Webometrics Ranking of World's Universities our university ranked 16th in the national ranking of 297 universities in Ukraine. University was awarded as a winner of the exhibition contest "Modern educational establishments – 2016" and received the Grand Prix "Leader of international activities". University has international connections with more than 50 educational, scientific and industrial institutions all over the world. It should be noted that "Secure, clean and efficiency energy" as the National contact point of Horizon2020 program acts on the PoltNTU basis.
